Winter Competitions

The full score lists for the qualifying rounds in each of our indoor competitions are enclosed. Target sets for the finalists in the Medal and CanDicap are also enclosed. These have to be shot by 14th Merch. 1977 and be back in my hands not later than Saturday. 19th March. 1977. In the Finals, the cards have to be shot as sets and ties will be determined by tie-shooting. N.S.R.A. rules apply.

The Final of the Speedway for the Bill Dick Memorial Trophy will take place at the Perth C.&C. range on Sunday, 27th March, shooting starting at 10.30 a.m. Trophy goes to the highest total of match points after the series of shoulder-to-shoulder matches. The top eight in the final table qualify automatically for selection for the Scottish team to shoot the postal indoor match against New Zealand.

1977 Team Trials

The list is now open for entries to the postal stage (a double Dewar, i.e. 40 shots at 50 yards and 40 shots at 100 yards), fee 50 pence payable with entry (below). The postal will be completed by the end of April with the best 25 shooting a shoulder-to-shoulder trial at Perth on Sunday, 8th May, to determine the 12 to go into the Final trial with the 1976 squad at Aberdeen on Sunday, 22nd May. Mr. A.M. Allan has been seeded into the 1977 squad which will number 20. It is proposed to form the 1978 squad by the end of October to allow a winter training programme to be developed. Summer outdoor league, open meeting and match performances will be taken into account.

Coaching

Alister Allan advises that he will be happy to try to answer all the requests from groups of members for his coaching services. He is equally at home with air rifle and .22 prone rifle and enquiries will be passed on to him promptly.

1977 Fund-raising

The large prize draw of the past two years will be rested this year. There is still the need to raise substantial sums of money to pursue our aims, in particular we shall be facing a contribution of at least £400 in 1978 to send our two representatives to the Commonwealth Games in Canada. The Council has therefore decided to invite all members (or in groups) to have a go at sponsored shoots with the proceeds for the Match Fund. It will have a different appeal to a prize draw and if even £2 per member can be cleared, the cumulative sum would be handsome. A separate form will be sent out explaining how it can be run and the best period to do it would be in the quiet spell between mid March and mid April.
