Winter Competitions

The full qualifying results list accompanies this letter plus the Finals targets for the Qualifiers. The last date for shooting is 2nd March, 1981, and all shot cards must be back in my hands for scoring not later than Sunday, 8th March, 1981.

Both the Medal (3 cards) and the CanDicap (2 cards) are to be shot as a set under N.S.R.A. rules and ties will be resolved by a tie-shoot. Entries for all three competitions were good with Medal 302, Speedway 145 and CanDicap 115.

Eley have advised with regret that a severe pruning of their promotional budget has forced them to withdraw their annual donation of the Silver Salvers. There is also a question-mark over the Supershoot series due to the lack of co-sponsors. However, the class prizes for the Medal competition will continue to be good quality engraved salvers and we would like to thank Eley for the excellent support they have given us over the years.

Air Weapons Championships

Further to the report at the A.G.M. of the need to find a new venue for the 1981 meeting, the Pistol Association decided to continue for this year in the small hall at Meadowbank and will be holding their championship meeting there on 14th/15th February. The S.S.R.A. is postponing the rifle championship meeting until the autumn when a suitable venue will be chosen. It is hoped to re-unite the meetings in 1982.

The Final trial will be held at the Denwood Range, Aberdeen, on Sunday, 17th May, 1981.

Squad Qualification, 1982

Shooters who wish to be considered for the N.S.R.A. National Squads are reminded that the system is via good performance in Authorised Shoots. It is their own responsibility to nominate in advance with the N.S.R.A. which authorised shoots they wish to have considered. All five of the S.S.R.A. Grand Prix Open Meetings and the Perthshire Open are authorised for this purpose.

Calendar of Events 1981

Highlights of the programme are:-

- (i) The five Association Grand Prix meetings from which will emerge the 1981 Scottish 50 metres Champion. Each combines a prize shoot in classes with a squadded scratch event for championship points. In 1981, medals are to replace cash prizes for the winners of the class events and performance diplomas will be presented to each Grand Prix prize list. The sponsorship from D. Crockart & Son, Stirling, will provide a £20 first prize for each Grand Prix in place of the previous Gold Awards to the overall Champion.
- (ii) The four-discipline shoot at Blair Atholl on Sunday, 24th May, run by Mr. S.D. Nicoll, which proved very popular last year and was won by a smallbore man, Douglas Anderson of Dunfermline. The competition is 10 shots each fullbore, smallbore, pistol and clay pigeon good weapons may be borrowed on the range.
- (iii) The three excellent indoor meetings (Perthshire, Glasgow Rail and Lanarkshire) which round off the winter season.

Frauchie/Wilkinson Sword, 1981

The Freuchie Individual Knock Out Competition will again be run at the Scottish Meeting, 27th June - 3rd July at Stirling. As before, the draw is made in groups of 3 with the winner over 20 shots at 100 yards going through to the next round. Entries are taken on the range but early entry is favoured as the timetable places a top limit of 81 entries. Draw is made on Sunday, 28th June, 6 p.m., first round the Monday 1 p.m., second round the Tuesday 1 p.m., semi-final Thursday. 1 p.m. and Final on the Thursday at 5.30 p.m. The unexpected often happens!! Summer Individual Leagues
