# Winter Competitions

The full qualifying results list accompanies this letter, together with the Finals targets for the Qualifiers. The last date for shooting is 28th February, 1985, and all shot cards must be back in my hands for scoring not later than Wednesday, 6th March, 1985.

Both the <u>Medal</u> (3 cards) and the <u>CanDicap</u> (2 cards only) are to be shot as a set under N.S.R.A. rules and ties will be resolved by a tie-shoot. The four Class winners (plus the Junior winner) in the Medal will each receive an engraved Salver and the Association Silver Medal goes to the overall best score.

Stickers for the 3-Position second stage are enclosed. This round is also to be shot by 28th February, 1985. Top ten scorers in the second stage qualify for the Final.

#### Summer Competitions

Overleaf is the 1985 Calendar of Events. Your attention is drawn especially to:

- (a) The five Grand Prix events comprising the Scottish 50 Metres Championship. In addition to being individually exciting events, championship points are accumulated over the five to produce the 1985 Order of Merit, for the top four places of which handsome prizes are awarded.
- (b) The Freuchie (Wilkinson Sword) Individual Knock-Out Competition again to be run during the Scottish Meeting, 22nd 28th June, at St. Andrews. As before, the draw is made in groups of 3 with the winner over 20 shots at 100 yards going through to the next round. Entries are taken on the range but early entry is advised as there is a limit of 81 entries. Draw is made on Sunday, 23rd June, 6 p.m., first round the Monday 1 p.m., second round the Tuesday 1 p.m., semi-final Thursday, 1 p.m. and Final on the Thursday at 5.30 p.m. The unexpected often happens!! There are prizes for all three finalists. Return the entry form below NOW to book your place.

There is a separate prize for the best C and D performance. It will be decided by a parallel final of the top three from these classes in the round in which their number falls to three of less, viz. if six reach round 2 and two reach the Semi, the three in the C & D final will be the two winners plus the top gunscore of the four losers.

(c) The S.S.R.A. Open Meeting at Perth on 8th/9th June, to which this year's Perth Grand Prix will be added. Excellent prizes are on offer and residual proceeds will benefit the Association funds. Details can be had in due course from Bill Moonie, Flat ld, St. Valery Drive, Stirling, or via the Secretary.

# (i) Open Air Weapons Meeting

The 1985 Open Meeting is to be run by S.A.R.P.A. at the Scottish Sports Council (Inverclyde) National Centre, Largs, on 20th/21st April. There will be a full Programme of air rifle and pistol competitions at 10 metres and 6 yards. Field Target shooting will be introduced on the Saturday (weapons available for all to try it!) with prize competitions on the Sunday. The N.S.R.A. has agreed to support the indoor meeting and Webley and Scott the field target competitions.

Entry Forms are now available for all events from the Secretary who wishes to draw attention to the attractive residential package the Centre offers. Full board from Friday tea to Sunday tea is £27.50 inclusive; full board over one night is £15.

### (ii) S.A.R.P.A. Summer Leagues

Individual leagues will again be run in Air Rifle and Air Pistol at 10 metres and 6 yards and are open to all members of S.A.R.P.A. and S.S.R.A. Interest from those not presently shooting in the winter leagues should be notified to the Secretary by end March. The 6-yard leagues cater in addition for recoilling weapons.

It is their own responsibility to nominate in advance with the N.S.R.A. which authorised shoots they wish to have considered. All five Grand Prix Open Meetings and the Perthshire Open are authorised for this purpose.
