Commonwealth Games - Postal Trial

I apologise for the delay in getting the scores to you. Peter Leddy was gey thrang hence my involvement at this late state. Subject to Committee confirmation, I have waived a minor technical breach which arose, i.e. the use of metres cards instead of yards cards by three competitors.

By the conditions of selection, all competitors scoring 1149 and better qualify for Stage 2, to be shot shoulder-to-shoulder at Perth and Aberdeen on 22nd July and 26th August respectively. The top ten aggregate scores in Stage 2 (ex 2400) will make up the squad to shoot off for the two team places and reserves at Gagie, by Dundee, in September. In the Final Stage, I.S.U. Rules will apply.

The immediate step is for all 50 qualifiers to be at the Perth City & County Club range, off Rae Place, Dunkeld Road, Perth (near the Ice Rink) on Sunday, 22nd July, at 9.30 a.m. for a prompt 10 o'clock start. Two squads will be formed and each will shoot two sets of 6 x 50 yards. The Stage 2 entry fee of 50p should be sent to me by return to book your place on the starting grid, although we are prepared to accept it at Perth when you arrive.

I look forward to a full turnout as the surplus from the entry fees will be used to help send the team to New Zealand.

Commonwealth Games 1974

I enclose the final result sheet for the Stage II Trials which have determined the 10 competitors to go forward to the Final Trial at Gagie on 16th September. The success of the two shoots we have already had is a tribute to the clubs which have staged them. For yesterday's very well organised day I would like to extend the Association's thanks to all the Bon Accord members who worked so hard preparing the range. Our thanks also go to Sandy Stronach for his adjudication, Bill Jaffray for his administration and Paul Shand and Hen Duncan for their donations. The funds had a net gain of £5.40 for the day.

The Final Trial will be staged in strict compliance with I.S.U. rules with the exception that the targets will again be the 3-card system, 5 shots per diagram but with detail times of two 30 minutes and one 40 minutes and with 10 minutes changing time allowed between details. You will need clips and your own shooting mats. The Chief Adjudicator will be Mr. J. Sibbald. The shoots are at 10.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. To allow time for the necessary careful checking of equipment you are requested to be present on the range by 9.30 a.m.

While adjustments can be made at the Range, any competitor unable to meet the I.S.U. requirements by the start of shooting will be disqualified. I would be grateful to have an early note from the ten qualifiers confirming their attendance under these conditions. If there are any prior withdrawals the Committee will invite replacements in order of the "Grand Total" scores achieved in Stage II.

Steeple Club will be our hosts at Gagie. To reach the range follow the Dundee-Arbroath road (A92) to the Claypots circle at the City boundary. Turn North and proceed for 2-3 miles. The range lies to the right (will be sign-posted) between a wood and the premises of Autoparts. As Autoparts operate on a Sunday, please park close in on the left side leading up from the main road and not beyond the notice board. The club is hoping to make hot pies, crisps and soft drinks available.
