My commiserations to Simon Riley who ended up 4th despite scoring the same number of total points as the winner. Only 1 point on his last 10 shots would have made a difference.

The willing help given by some made my job easier this time and the range was left in a good clean condition. The only gripe I still have is that so many of you never seem to manage to get your Entry Forms and cheques in on time and I absolutely hate getting cash on the range. At the moment, I'm 16 down, so, please help next time by getting your Form in on time and minimise the trouble trying to sort out left-handers and classification on the range. Thank you.
